Pastor's Pen-"DOING WHAT LOVE REQUIRES: Stewardship 2021/22"

October is stewardship month at Calvary. It's a topic that can make people twitchy, especially IF they believe stewardship is about the church "getting their money." Stewardship is about God getting your heart. Faith in action comes from the heart. In Micah 6:8 we read, "What does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?" (NRSV). The verses that precede Micah 6:8 show God talking to Israel. In essence God says, "I have something I need to bring to your attention, a controversy I need to voice, so listen up. What exactly have I done wrong? I am constantly saving you so that you will always remember my righteous deeds." What follows are the Israelites asking questions as if they're trying to break the code of what God wants from them.

What, O God, are the proper offerings that might be fitting as a response to your saving acts? Is it a year-old calf? Or how about thousands of rams, or ten thousand of rivers of oil? The last verse of the passage — the one most familiar to us — turns the questions asked in verses 6-7 away from their focus on the types of offerings and toward a focus on the type of person.



God does not want a specific type of offering. God wants a specific type of person.

The passage culminates with an answer-Micah 6:8. The people have focused on offerings — small and large. They have emphasized sacrificial worship to the exclusion of justice and kindness. **Doing What Love Requires** is our Stewardship theme this year. Its hope is to focus us on how we can use our resources (our finances and our very lives), to show mercy, to love kindness and to walk humbly. We do this as individuals, but we also do it as organized communities of faith. Financial stewardship stems from our heart for God.

Calvary has a lot to look forward to. The holy excitement of calling a settled pastor is on the horizon. God already knows who that individual is. This year we've faithfully worn our masks to care for neighbor. We've gotten our vaccinations and we've kept our social distance. That's one way we've shown love, mercy and kindness. The next step is to ensure that our ministry as Calvary Lutheran Church of Morro Bay is resourced for the next year and beyond. Expect a letter and a pledge card in the mail. It's signed by each one of your leaders. What if the best is yet to come? Guess what? It is.

Our transition/call committee is in full swing and hopes to complete the ministry site profile (MSP) by the end of September. Once processed by the synod it's possible the call committee could be talking with candidates in October.



Advent begins on Nov. 28. Pastor would like to use a series called, "The Inn: Housing the Holy." A motion was made and passed to allow the purchase of \$79 for the materials.

The Daisy group (a group of young girls organized by Angelina McKee) has been approved to use the patio and office building for their meetings once monthly, and because they have no funding to make a donation they will do chores as they are able, such as cleaning the tables and sweeping.

Outreach Committee



The committee voted to recommend to the Council that the proceeds from selling jewelry at the yard sale go to purchasing "ELCA Good Gifts" at Christmas time. The gifts to choose from provide things like chickens, pigs, fresh water and filters, etc. in other countries. Also approved was a drive for donations for Iglesia for cleaning supplies and other needed items.

The Calvary Member photo wall needs to be completed before we get a new pastor. Most of the photos have been taken by Jim Luke. Kathie Sperow has contacted some of those who have not had a picture taken and asked them to bring a picture of themselves to put on the wall.

Some members have expressed a desire to be trained to take Communion to those who are not comfortable coming to church yet. Pastor will check her calendar and schedule a training the first of November.

Treasurer's Report for August, 2021

Income - \$6,035.00; Expenses - \$5,227.79. Income at the end of August is now at 107.6% of our 2021 Budget for the first 8 months of 2021. Expenses are at 92.4% of the 2021 Budget for the same period.

PUMPKIN SHEET CAKE (RECIPE BY REE DRUMMOND, PIONEER WOMAN)

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 and prepare a sheet pan (11X17)
- 2. In a medium saucepan: Melt 2 sticks salted **butter**, then add 2 cups **pumpkin puree** (not pumpkin pie mix), ½ cup boiling water and 1 tsp. **pumpkin pie spice**
- 3. In large bowl combine: 2 cups flour, 2 cups white sugar, ½ tsp. salt. Set aside.
- 4. In medium bowl, combine: ½ cup buttermilk OR ½ cup milk and 1 tsp. white vinegar, 2 beaten eggs, 2 tsp. baking soda, 2 tsp. vanilla
- 5. Pour pumpkin mixture into flour mixture, stir until partially combined. Add buttermilk mixture and stir until fully combined. Pour onto prepared sheet pan and bake for 20 minutes. Cool fully before frosting.
- **6.** To make **cream cheese frosting**, use one stick of butter and 8 oz. of cream cheese, both warmed to room temp. Mix in 1 tsp. vanilla and a little milk as you beat in 1 lb. powdered sugar.




