Pastor's Pen: Stewardship of Summer

"The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof." (Psalm 24:1)

The arrival of summer always makes me nostalgic for summers past. This week I found myself remembering 1980 when I lived in Belgium and was editor of the community newspaper for S.H.A.P.E. (Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe) at NATO. I was sent on assignment to the palace of Versailles in Versailles, France to write about the **Fete de Nuit**, (night festival). Fete de Nuit is a spectacle of music, lights, elaborate water

fountains, horses, dancers and theater, all set in the palace gardens. Every bit of it is choreographed to George Frederick Handle's "Water Music." Then it ends with a sensory shattering fireworks display perfectly set to his "Fireworks Suite!" While others were clapping, I was weeping. In that moment I remembered my mother playing Handle, describing what she saw in her imagination. "Can you see it Robyn?" she'd ask. It would take me until that night in France to answer yes. Because that night



in Versailles, I finally saw what my mother had tried to show me. I phoned her that same night to say how incredibly beautiful the night had been, and how grateful I was for what she tried to impart.

Clearly, there are times in life when the light bulb comes on. It happens often in our faith; when the impact of a teaching or a bible passage comes to life in a new way. I've always understood the basics of God's love of creation and God's desire for us to be good stewards of the earth and all who inhabit it, however, this month as we enter the season of vacations, it's becoming clearer. The ELCA is talking more and more of eco faith, eco systems, climate change, and energy and water stewardship. The more I am outdoors the more I marvel at God's beauty. But I wonder. Have I, have we, grasped the symphony and synchronicity God has built into the creation we humans often take for granted? What does it mean to be given dominion over something? Do we understand the sacred nature of water? Do we understand that our bodies are also delicate eco-systems? By what we put into our bodies, are we polluting or caring for them? God has blessed and made a covenant with all of creation and we are blessed to be a blessing—to ourselves, to each other, and to our world.

I pray that every time you and your family are outdoors enjoying summer adventures, you will stop to marvel and appreciate God's creation.

Council met on Thursday, May 13



The current balance in the Chase General Fund checking account is \$23,058.04 as of May 12th, 2021. Actual Income for April 2021 was \$6,126.00; Actual Expenses were \$5,518.28. Net income of \$607.72.

Council voted to allow the outside groups (AA, OA) to begin using the office building and Fellowship Hall for meetings without using the kitchen after we determine the number of people in each group and what the guidelines are now.

Six to eight people will be needed to form a Call Committee. The Committee will be refreshing Calvary's Mission & Vision statements and creating a Ministry Site Narrative that will explain who we are and what we need. The Committee will work with the Finance Committee to create a package to present to prospective pastors.


